*Tuition Exemption

Regular (degree-seeking) students with excellent academic records who experience financial difficulty may apply for a full or half tuition exemption after their enrollment to KU.

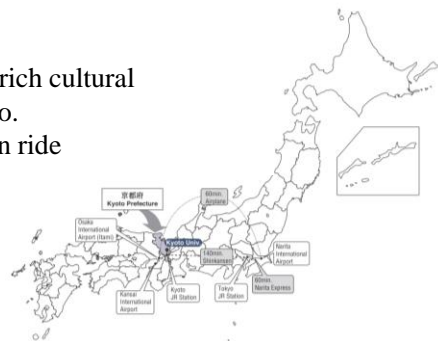
KU is located in a rich cultural heritage city, Kyoto.
