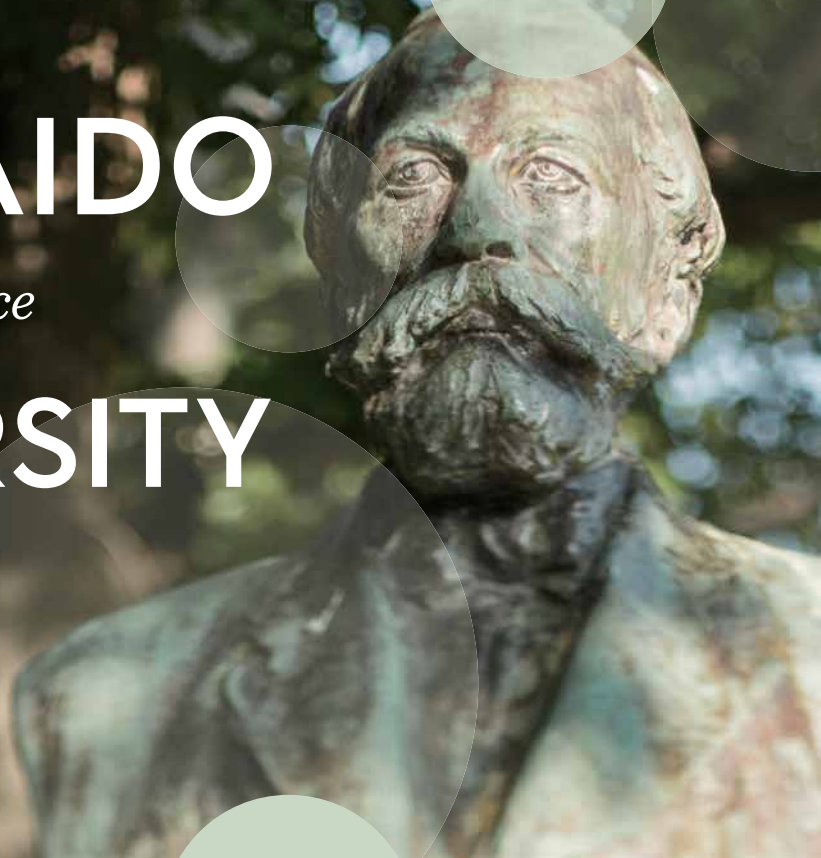

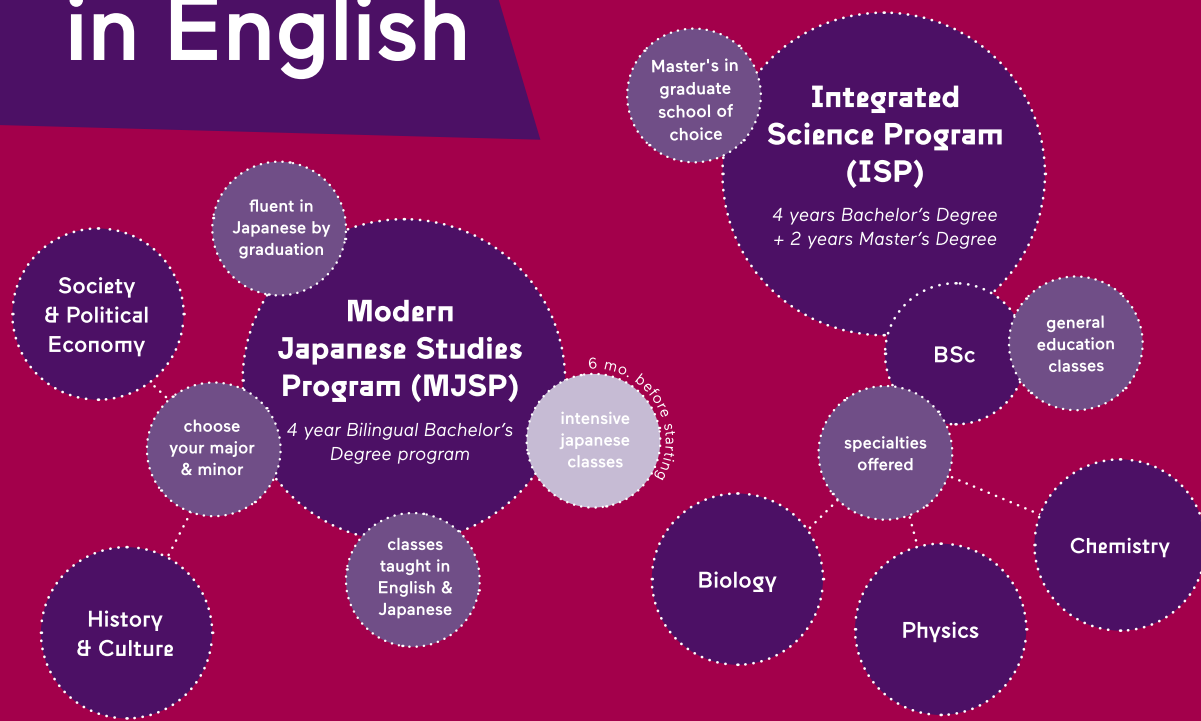

## Sapporo Campus

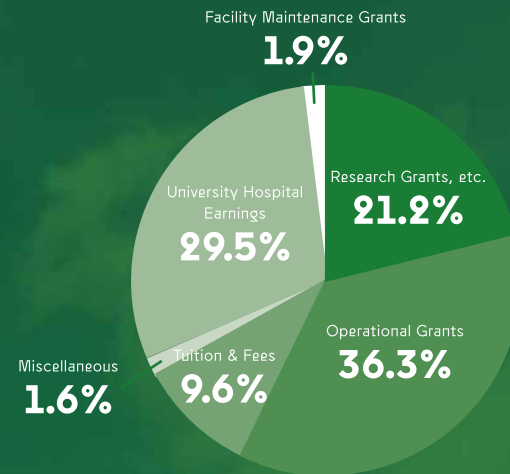
